The goal of this event is to elevate self-esteem and spark big career dreams for students.



The day starts with local female professionals who share about their career paths, give advice, and answer career questions, followed by a day of mentorship between students and female professionals guided by the JA It's My Future® curriculum. Students will be encouraged to investigate, ask questions, and be inspired to consider STEM careers for their futures.
